The lots originating from private collections were particularly successful, as shown by the Fritz Schlumpf collection where 100% of the lots were sold (please see separate post-sale release), and that of Jean Hugues for his gallery Le Point Cardinal, which offered two marble sculptures by Augustin Cardenas (lots 5 and 9) that were sold for €55,000 and €37,500 respectively. Finally, many buyers pushed the doors to the Christie's saleroom for the first time, participating in a record-breaking sale since the creation of this cross-category genre in 2001 ».
