Highlights include a core group of <u>George II solid mahogany seating</u> furniture, <u>Neoclassic</u> designs of the <u>Regency</u> period and scarlet and <u>black gilt-japanned cabinets</u> from The Barbara Allen de Kwiatkowski Collection.

Traveling to the Continent, we find a diverse assortment of Louis XV and Louis XVI ormolu objects including sets of <u>wall lights</u> and a <u>mantel clock</u> after the emblematic design by François Vion, as well as a curated selection of furniture such as a <u>pair of Louis XVI marquises</u> delivered for Charles Alexandre de Calonne, Louis XVI's famous finance minister, at Versailles. Among the silver and ceramics offerings, highlights include works by the pre-eminent silversmiths <u>Georg Jensen</u> and <u>Puiforcat</u>, and important pâte-sur-pâte vases by <u>Léopold-Jules-Joseph Gély</u> and <u>Louis Solon</u> while working at the Sèvres and Minton factories, respectively.
